A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to free registration plates for certain
2 disabled veterans.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point one
5 hundred five (321.105), unnumbered paragraph three (3), Code
6 1973, is amended to read as follows:

7 Seriously disabled veterans who have been provided with
8 an automobile or other vehicle by the United States government
9 under the provisions of ~~section-4904~~ sections one thousand
10 nine hundred one (1901) through one thousand nine hundred three
11 (1903) inclusive, Title 38 of the United States Code, [38
12 U.S.C. §1901 ~~(4964)~~ et seq. one thousand nine hundred seventy
13 (1970)] shall be exempt from payment of ~~the~~ any automobile
14 registration fee provided in this chapter, and shall be pro-
15 vided, without fee, with a ~~license~~ registration plate. The
16 disabled veteran, to be able to claim the above benefit,
17 must be a resident of the state of Iowa and must produce a
18 certificate of title to the automobile owned and registered
19 in this state in the name of said veteran.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill will allow all disabled veterans who receive a
22 grant to buy an automobile or other conveyance from the federal
23 government, to receive the registration plates for their
24 automobiles from the state without charge. Under present Iowa
25 law, only those veterans who chose to buy an automobile with

1 the federal grant are eligible for free registration plates.
2 Those disabled veterans who chose to buy a tractor or other
3 vehicle allowed by the U. S. Veterans Administration do not
4 receive free registration plates for their automobiles.

5 The word "license" was incorrectly used in lieu of the
6 word "registration" in the original Act, Acts of the
7 Sixtieth General Assembly, chapter one hundred ninety-two (192),
8 section one (1). The error has been noted by the Code Editor
9 and the correct word "registration" has been substituted.

10 The bill corrects this error by statute.
