1 Section 1. Section thirty-one point seven (31.7), Code
2 1973, is amended to read as follows:

3 31.7 VETERANS' DAY. The governor is hereby authorized
4 and requested to issue annually a proclamation designating
5 the ~~fourth-Monday-in-October~~ eleventh day of November as
6 Veterans' Day and calling upon the people of Iowa to observe
7 it as a legal holiday in honor of those who have been members
8 of the armed forces of the United States, and urging state
9 officials to display the American flag on all state and school
10 buildings and the people of the state to display the flag at
11 their homes, lodges, churches and places of business; that
12 business activities be held to the necessary minimum; and that
13 appropriate services and exercises be had expressive of the
14 public sentiments befitting the occasion.

15 Sec. 2. Section thirty-three point one (33.1), subsection
16 seven (7), Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:

17 7. Veterans' Day, ~~the-fourth-Monday-in-October~~ November 11.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill changes the observance date of Veterans' Day
20 from the fourth Monday in October to November 11.
