Prepared in regard to H.F. 28 - An Act relating to a free copy of the laws of Iowa. Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal as required by House Rule 48.

Each copy of the 1971 Code of Iowa costs \$62.83. Based on that, the cost for furnishing a free copy of the Code to each of the 99 Board of Supervisors would be \$6,220.

It is anticipated by the Superintendent of Printing that due to some new techniques of printing the 1973 Code will be somewhat less. No exact cost is available at the present time.
