A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to trout stamps.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

3 Section 1. Section one hundred ten point one (110.1),
4 lines seventeen (17) through twenty-three (23), Code 1973,
5 are amended to read as follows:

6 No person, resident or nonresident, required to have a
7 fishing license, shall ~~fish-for-trout-in-waters-designated~~
8 ~~by-the-state-conservation-commission-as-"trout-waters"~~
9 ~~without-having-a-special-license-stamp-affixed-to-his~~
10 ~~fishing-license~~ have in his possession, trout, unless at
11 the time of such possession he has on his person an unex-
12 pired special trout license stamp validated by his signa-
13 ture written across the face of the stamp in ink. A person
14 who has not reached his sixteenth birthday is not required
15 to have a trout license stamp.

EXPLANATION

17
18 This bill provides that a person having trout in his pos-
19 session shall have a special trout license stamp, validated
20 by having his signature written across the face of the stamp.
21 The Code now requires a trout stamp to fish in "designated
22 waters". Trout waters are presently designated by placing
23 signs at the start and end of each trout water. Trout
24 movement above and below these signs after stocking has
25 created enforcement and management problems that would be

1 corrected by the proposed Code amendment.
2 This Code modification will also allow trout stocking
3 in additional waters not presently stocked due to difficulty
4 in posting signs on such waters. Enforcement would be aided
5 by eliminating the need of the officer to determine where
6 anglers were fishing when they are in possession of trout
7 and prevent the passing of trout stamps from angler to
8 angler by requiring validation in the form of a signature
9 on the stamp.
