2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
3 Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-five point seven-
4 teen (365.17), Code 1973, is amended by striking subsection
5 seven (7).

EXPLANATION

7 This bill eliminates the prohibition of persons classified
8 as conscientious objectors from serving in a civil service
9 position.
