3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-eight point three (148.3),
2 subsection three (3), Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:

3 3. Present to the state department of health satisfactory
4 evidence that applicant has completed one year of internship
5 in a hospital approved by the state board of medical examiners.
6 However, the medical examiners may accept the completion of
7 training as a resident physician and surgeon in lieu of intern-
8 ship requirements. The training shall be approved by or be
9 acceptable to the medical examiners. No hospital shall be
10 approved which does not provide the internship without expense
11 to the intern.

12 Sec. 2. Section one hundred fifty A point three (150A.3),
13 subsection one (1), paragraph c, Code 1973, is amended to
14 read as follows:

15 c. Present to the state department of health satisfactory
16 evidence that the applicant has completed one year of
17 internship in a hospital approved by the medical examiners.
18 No hospital shall be approved which does not provide the
19 internship without expense to the intern. Until July 1, 1968,
20 any osteopathic hospital which has been approved by the
21 American Osteopathic Association for internship training
22 shall, by virtue thereof, stand as provisionally approved
23 by the medical examiners unless the medical examiners, by
24 majority action, including the osteopathic physician and
25 surgeon member, shall disapprove. However, the medical
26 examiners may accept the completion of training as a resident
27 osteopathic physician and surgeon in lieu of internshin
28 requirements. The training shall be approved or be acceptable
29 to the medical examiners.

30 EXPLANATION

31 This bill allows the Board of Medical Examiners to waive
32 internship requirements for physicians and surgeons and
33 osteopathic physicians and surgeons and to accept completion
34 of training as a resident physician and surgeon or osteopathic
35 physician and surgeon.
