A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the qualifications of the commissioner of
2 public health.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Section one hundred thirty-five point two
5 (135.2), Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:

6 135.2 APPOINTMENT. The governor shall, within sixty days
7 after the convening of the general assembly in 1925, and every
8 four years thereafter, appoint, with the approval of two-thirds
9 of the members of the senate, a commissioner of public health
10 who shall be ~~a-physician-specially-trained-in-public-hygiene~~
11 ~~and-sanitation~~ qualified in the general field of health
12 administration.

EXPLANATION

13
14 This bill removes the qualification for the commissioner
15 of public health to be a physician trained in public hygiene
16 and sanitation.
