1 Section 1. Section seventy-one point one (71.1), Code
2 1973, is amended to read as follows:

3 71.1 EMPLOYMENTS PROHIBITED. It shall hereafter be unlaw-
4 ful for any person elected or appointed to any public office
5 or position under the laws of the state or by virtue of the
6 ordinance of any city or town in the state, to appoint as deputy,
7 clerk, or helper in said office or position to be paid from the
8 public funds, any person related by consanguinity or affinity,
9 within the third degree, to the person elected, appointed, or
10 making said appointment, unless such appointment shall first be
11 approved by the officer, board, council, or commission whose duty
12 it is to approve the bond of the principal; provided this pro-
13 vision shall not apply in cases where such person appointed
14 receives compensation at the rate of six hundred dollars per
15 year or less, nor shall it apply to persons teaching in public
16 schools, nor shall it apply to the employment of clerks of
17 members of the general assembly.

18 Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force on and
19 retroactive to January 1, 1973, after its publication in
20 The Tipton Conservative, a newspaper published in
21 Tipton, Iowa, and in The Tri-County News,
22 a newspaper published in Farmington, Iowa.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill allows members of the General Assembly to employ
25 persons related by marriage or blood as clerks. The bill pro-
26 vides that this exception be retroactive to January 1, 1973.
