1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state the sum of nine thousand four hundred six dol-  
3 lars and ninety-seven cents (\$9,406.97), or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, to pay the expenses incurred on account  
5 of the inaugural ceremonies and reception.

6 Warrants for payment of expenses authorized under this  
7 Act shall be drawn in favor of the adjutant general upon the  
8 filing of vouchers therefor with the state comptroller.

9 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
10 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publi-  
11 cation in The Nashua Reporter, a newspaper published in Nashua,  
12 Iowa, and in the Onawa Democrat, a newspaper published in  
13 Onawa, Iowa.
