## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the cost of uniforms for county conservation  
 2 officers and employees.  
 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:  
 4 Section 1. Section one hundred eleven A point four (111A.4),  
 5 subsection ten (10), Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:  
 6 10. To furnish suitable uniforms for the executive officer  
 7 and such employees as he may designate to wear, when on official  
 8 duty. The cost of said uniforms shall not ~~be~~ exceed three hundred  
 9 dollars per person in any given year. The uniforms shall at  
 10 all times remain the property of the county.

### EXPLANATION

11  
 12 This bill strikes the limitation of expense for county  
 13 conservation uniforms. Present law appears to limit the  
 14 expenditure to \$300 for each county per year.
