A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state
2 to the higher education facilities commission administra-
3 tive funds and funds for the medical student tuition loan
4 program.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

8 REPORT OF HOUSE COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS
(House File 683)

9 Higher Education Facilities Commission

10 The committee recommendation is for an appropriation to the Higher
11 Education Facilities Commission for the purpose of general office expenses
12 of \$115,040.00 for 1973-74 and \$118,520.00 for 1974-75. This appropriation
13 includes compensation for the loss of federal funds used for administra-
14 tion of Section 1202 State Commissions.

15 From this total, \$78,190.00 for 1973-74 and \$80,770.00 for 1974-75 is
16 appropriated for salaries.

17 \$2,470.00 for 1973-74 and \$2,530.00 for 1974-75 is appropriated for
18 travel.

19 \$19,534.00 for 1973-74 and \$19,554.00 for 1974-75 is appropriated for pro-
20 fessional and scientific services.

21 \$14,486.00 for 1973-74 and \$15,704.00 for 1974-75 is appropriated for
22 office supplies and expense, printing and binding, telephone and telegraph,
23 building rental, utilities, dues, and Commission member expense.

24 The committee recommendation allows for no increase in personnel.

25 Medical Student Tuition Program

The committee recommendation is for an appropriation of \$125,000.00 for
1973-74, and no appropriation for 1974-75.

The committee recommendation stipulates that this appropriation be used
only to fund the ongoing program, and that no new students be added to
this program.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state of Iowa to the higher education facilities com-
3 mission for each fiscal year of the biennium beginning July
4 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975, the following amounts, or
5 so much thereof as may be necessary to be used for the fol-
6 lowing designated purposes:

21 the provisions of section
22 two hundred sixty-one point
23 two (261.2) of the Code,
24 the following amounts:

25 Funds appropriated pursuant to subsection two (2) of this
26 section to finance loans to Iowa resident medical students
27 during the 1973-1974 fiscal year shall be made available only
28 to those students who receive funds under such program from
29 funds appropriated for the 1971-1973 fiscal biennium.

30 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
31 of the commission are appropriated for the purpose set forth
32 in such federal grants or receipts.

33 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
34 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code all unencumbered or
35 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for

1 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1,
2 1973 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury
3 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In
4 all other respects the provisions of section eight point
5 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations
6 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencum-
7 bered or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the
8 second fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to sec-
9 tion eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

10 Sec. 4. When any of the laws of this state are in con-
11 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern
12 for the biennium.
