A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to persons permitted to inspect certain
2 records and reports of the employment security commission.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
4 Section 1. Section ninety-six point eleven (96.11), subsec-
5 tion seven (7), Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:
6 7. RECORDS AND REPORTS. Each employing unit shall keep
7 true and accurate work records, containing such information
8 as the commission may prescribe. Such records shall be open
9 to inspection and be subject to being copied by the commission
10 or its authorized representatives at any reasonable time and
11 as often as may be necessary. The commission may require
12 from any employing unit any sworn or unsworn reports, with
13 respect to persons employed by it, which the commission deems
14 necessary for the effective administration of this chapter.
15 Information thus obtained shall not be published or be open
16 to public inspection, other than to public employees in the
17 performance of their public duties or to an agent of the
18 commission designated as such in writing for the purpose of
19 accomplishing certain functions of the commission, in any
20 manner revealing the employing unit's identity, but any
21 claimant at a hearing before an appeal tribunal or the commis-
22 sion shall be supplied with information from such records
23 to the extent necessary for the proper presentation of his
24 claim. Any employee or member of the commission who violates
25 any provision of this section shall be fined not less than

1 twenty dollars nor more than two hundred dollars, or impris-
2 oned for not longer than ninety days, or both.

3 EXPLANATION

4 This bill provides that an agent of the Employment Security
5 Commission may inspect certain reports of employers required
6 by the Commission. This amendment is necessary to enable
7 the Commission to facilitate its transactions with banks in
8 which employer's contributions are deposited.
