1 Section 1. Section eight A point eleven (8A.11), Code
2 1973, is amended to read as follows:

3 8A.11 EXPENSES. The members of both the council and the
4 board shall ~~serve without compensation but shall be entitled~~
5 to be paid a forty dollar per diem and be reimbursed for
6 travel and actual and necessary expenses involved in attend-
7 ing meetings and in the performance of their duties. All
8 per diem and expense moneys paid to the members shall be paid
9 from funds appropriated to the department of general services.

10 Sec. 2. Section eighteen A point five (18A.5), Code 1973,
11 is amended to read as follows:

12 18A.5 COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. The members of the com-
13 mission shall be ~~paid~~ reimbursed for their actual and necessary
14 expenses and shall be paid a forty dollar per diem while in
15 attendance at any meeting of the commission held at the seat
16 of government and ~~in~~ shall be reimbursed for their expenses
17 for going to and from the seat of government to attend a
18 ~~meeting of such commission and while attending the same.~~
19 All per diem and expense moneys paid to the commissioners
20 shall be paid from funds appropriated to the commission.

21 Service of the superintendent of buildings and grounds and
22 the state architect upon this commission shall be an additional
23 duty conferred by statute.

24 Sec. 3. Section twenty-eight point two (28.2), Code 1973,
25 is amended to read as follows:

26 28.2 COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. The members of the com-
27 mission shall ~~receive such compensation as may be allowed~~
28 ~~by the general assembly~~ be paid a forty dollar per diem and
29 ~~they~~ shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary ex-
30 penses ~~actually~~ incurred in performing their duties as mem-
31 bers of the commission. All per diem and expense moneys paid
32 to the members shall be paid from funds appropriated to the
33 commission.

34 Sec. 4. Section sixty-seven point twelve (67.12), Code
35 1973, is amended to read as follows:

21 be considered to represent the viewpoint of mine workmen,
22 and two members shall be persons who, by reason of previous
23 training and experience, may reasonably be considered to rep-
24 resent the viewpoint of mine operators. One member of the
25 board, who shall be chairman of the board, and serve as a
26 representative of the public, shall not, within one year of
27 his appointment as a member of the board, have had a pecu-
28 niary interest in, or engaged in, the mining of coal or other
29 minerals, or have been an officer or representative of either
30 mine workers or operators. ~~Each member of the board shall~~
31 ~~in addition to necessary traveling and hotel expenses, receive~~
32 ~~twenty dollars per day while actually engaged in the perfor-~~
33 ~~mance of work of the board.~~ No The members of the board shall
34 be paid a forty dollar per diem and shall be reimbursed for
35 actual and necessary expenses incurred under the provisions

1 of this chapter. A member of the board shall not receive
2 more than four eight hundred dollars in per diem compensation
3 in any one year. All per diem and expense moneys paid to
4 the members shall be paid from funds appropriated to the
5 department of mines and minerals.

6 Sec. 7. Section ninety point seven (90.7), Code 1973,
7 is amended to read as follows:

8 90.7 COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. The members of the board
9 shall ~~receive a compensation of five dollars~~ be paid a forty
10 dollar per diem ~~for the time actually employed, together with~~
11 ~~their traveling and other~~ and shall be reimbursed for actual
12 and necessary expenses, the same these moneys to be payable
13 out of the state treasury upon warrants drawn by the state
14 comptroller.

7 (455A.7), Code 1973, is amended by striking the section and
8 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 455A.7 COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. The members of the
10 council, except those members who are employees of the state
11 or any political subdivision, shall be paid a forty dollar
12 per diem and shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary
13 expenses incurred under the provisions of this chapter; how-
14 ever, a member shall not receive more than three thousand
15 two hundred dollars per diem for each fiscal year. All per
16 diem and expense moneys paid to members shall be paid from
17 funds appropriated to the council. A member of the council
18 shall not have a direct financial interest in, or profit by
19 any of the operations of the council.

20 Sec. 18. Section four hundred fifty-five B point four
21 (455B.4), unnumbered paragraph three (3), Code 1973, is amended
22 to read as follows:

23 Each commission shall meet at least four times a year.
24 Other meetings shall be called by the chairman or upon writ-
25 ten request of a majority of the members of the commission.
26 The chairman shall preside at all meetings or in his absence
27 the vice-chairman shall preside. The executive director shall
28 attend the meetings of the commissions and act as secretary
29 for them. The members of each commission shall be paid a
30 forty dollar per diem ~~of-thirty-dollars~~ while in session,
31 ten cents a mile for travel, and their ~~reasonable~~ actual and
32 necessary expenses while attending such meetings. All per

8 meetings may be held at the call of the chairman. Three mem-
9 bers shall constitute a quorum. The members of the board
10 shall ~~serve without compensation, except~~ be paid a forty dol-
11 lar per diem and shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary

31 to commissioners shall be paid from funds appropriated to
32 the commission. The commission shall adopt, amend, or rescind
33 such rules as shall be necessary for the conduct of its
34 meetings. A quorum shall consist of four commissioners.

35 Sec. 22. Section six hundred one B point four (601B.4),

1 Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:

2 601B.4 COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. The members of the
3 commission shall ~~receive no compensation for their services,~~
4 but be paid a forty dollar per diem and shall be entitled
5 to receive reimbursed for their traveling actual and other
6 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties
7 as members of the commission. All per diem and expense moneys
8 paid to members shall be paid from funds appropriated to the
9 commission.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill provides a forty dollar per diem and allows
12 actual and necessary expenses for members of the following
13 boards (bill section numbers in parentheses): State
14 educational radio and television facility board and state
15 communications advisory council (Sec. 1), capitol planning
16 commission (Sec. 2), Iowa development commission (Sec. 3),
17 special accountant commission (Sec. 4), Iowa law enforcement
18 academy council (Sec. 5), state mining board (Sec. 6), boards
19 of arbitration (Sec. 7), state conservation commission (Sec.
20 8), plumbing code committee (Sec. 9), hospital licensing board
21 (Sec. 10), state board of health (Sec. 11), commission on
22 aging (Sec. 12), state board of public instruction (Sec. 13),
23 higher education facilities commission (Sec. 14), board of
24 trustees of the state traveling library (Sec. 15), aeronautics
25 commission (Sec. 16), natural resources council (Sec. 17),
26 the air quality, water quality, chemical technology and solid
27 waste disposal commissions (Sec. 18), board of certification
28 (Sec. 19), boundary commissions (Sec. 20), civil rights
29 commission (Sec. 21), and commission for the blind (Sec. 22).
