A BILL FOR

1 An Act appropriating funds transferred to the marine fuel
2 tax fund to the state conservation commission.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the marine fuel
2 tax fund for each fiscal year of the biennium beginning July
3 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975 to the state conservation
4 commission, division of lands and waters, such amounts of
5 funds computed as provided in section three hundred twenty-
6 four point eighty-four (324.84) of the Code, which funds shall
7 be deposited in the state conservation fund for use in the
8 state conservation commission recreational boating program
9 as provided in subsections one (1) through five (5) of sec-
10 tion three hundred twenty-four point seventy-nine (324.79)
11 of the Code. Notwithstanding section two (2) of this Act,
12 the unencumbered or unobligated balances of funds specifically
13 allocated for capital projects shall not revert to the fund
14 from which appropriated until June 30, 1977.

15 Not to exceed fifteen percent of the amount appropriated
16 under this section may be spent by the commission for repairs
17 and improvements in existing state parks in addition to any
18 specific projects set out in this section.

19 Funds appropriated by this Act for deposit in the state
20 conservation fund, which may be used for administrative
21 purposes, shall be subject to any limitation imposed in any
22 other Act of the general assembly upon the expenditure of
23 funds for administrative purposes, and the provisions of this
24 Act shall not be construed as making available funds for ad-
25 ministrative purposes which are in addition to any limita-
26 tion of funds for administrative purposes.

27 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
28 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
29 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
30 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
31 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and
32 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all
33 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
34 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
35 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered

1 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
 2 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
 3 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

4 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
 5 of the state conservation commission, division of lands and
 6 waters, are appropriated for the purpose set forth in the
 7 federal grants or receipts.

8 Sec. 4. Where any laws of this state are in conflict with
 9 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
 10 bienn

 commission's recreational boating program.

4 be allocated the sum of one hundred thousand dollars to
5 aid in the dredging of Blue Lake at Onawa, Iowa. However,
6 this allocation shall only be made if federal matching
7 funds are made available to carry out the dredging of
8 Blue Lake at Onawa, Iowa. If such federal matching funds
9 are not available on or before July 1, 1975, the funds
10 allocated for dredging Blue Lake shall revert to the
11 marine fuel tax fund."

3 "Sec. _____. Section three hundred twenty-four point seventeen
4 (324.17), unnumbered paragraph one (1), Code 1973, is amended to
5 read as follows:
6 Any person other than a licensee who shall use motor fuel for
7 the purpose of operating or propelling farm tractors, corn shel-
8 lers, roller mills, truck-mounted feed grinders, stationary gas
9 engines, aircraft, for cleaning or dyeing or for any purpose
10 other than in watercraft or in motor vehicles operated or intended
11 to be operated upon the public highways or public waterways and
12 having paid the motor fuel tax on the fuel either directly to the
13 department of revenue or by having the tax added to the price of
14 the fuel, and who has a refund permit shall, upon presentation to
15 and approval by the department of revenue of a claim for refun
16 be reimbursed and repaid the amount of the tax which the claimant
17 has paid on the gallonage so used. Every claim filed subsequent
18 to July 4, 1957, shall be subject to the following conditions:"
19 2. Page 1, line 1, after the word "Act" insert the words
20 "relating to and".
21 3. Renumber sections of the bill in accordance with this
