3 July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975 for the Iowa reciprocity

12 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
13 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
14 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
15 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
16 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and
17 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all
18 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
19 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
20 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
21 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
22 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
23 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

24 Sec. 3. Where any laws of this state are in conflict with
25 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
26 biennium.
