1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for each fiscal year of the biennium beginning
3 July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975, to the Iowa merit em-
4 ployment department, the following amounts, or so much there-
5 of as may be necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

10 Sec. 2. Section nineteen A point eight (19A.8), the last
11 unnumbered paragraph, Code 1973, is amended to read as fol-
12 lows:

13 The director shall quarterly render a statement to those
14 covered departments which operate in whole or in part from
15 other than general fund appropriations for a pro rata share
16 of the cost of administration of the merit employment de-
17 partment. Such expense shall be paid by the state depart-
18 ments or agencies in the same manner as other expenses of
19 such department are paid and the moneys received shall con-
20 ~~stitute a "repayment receipt" to the merit employment de-~~
21 ~~partment~~ be deposited in the general fund of the state.

22 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
23 of the Iowa merit employment department are appropriated for
24 the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

25 Sec. 4. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
26 for capital improvements.

27 Sec. 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
28 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
29 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
30 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
31 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and
32 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all
33 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
34 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
35 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered

1 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
2 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
3 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

4 Sec. 6. When any of the laws of this state are in con-
5 flict with sections one (1), three (3) and four (4) of this
6 Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the biennium.
