State Fair Board

The committee recommendation is for a total appropriation of \$280,000.00 for 1973-74 and \$280,000.00 for 1974-75.

From this total, \$60,000.00 for 1973-74 and \$60,000.00 for 1974-75 is appropriated for maintenance of buildings and grounds. \$10,000.00 for 1973-74 and \$10,000.00 for 1974-75 is appropriated for premiums.

\$210,000.00 for 1973-74 and \$210,000.00 for 1974-75 is appropriated for agricultural societies (local fairs).

The committee recommendation represents no increase over the previous biennium.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
 2 of the state to the state fair board for each fiscal year  
 3 of the biennium beginning July 1, 1973 and ending June 30,  
 4 1975, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be  
 5 necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

15 The appropriations for state aid to agricultural societies  
 16 shall be deemed conditional on full compliance with all other  
 17 statutes which regulate and prescribe the conditions under  
 18 which such aid is payable. In no case shall any county receive  
 19 more than two thousand one hundred (2,100) dollars, except  
 20 that in a county where there are two definitely separate  
 21 county extension offices, each such society shall receive  
 22 state aid in such amount as it would be entitled to if it  
 23 were the only society in the county. In counties having more  
 24 than one fair entitled to state aid, the state aid available  
 25 for the county shall be prorated to said fairs on the basis  
 26 of cash premiums paid by said fairs.

27 Sec. 2. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used  
 28 for capital improvements.

29 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
 30 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
 31 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
 32 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973  
 33 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and  
 34 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all  
 35 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-

1 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made  
2 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered  
3 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second  
4 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight  
5 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

6 Sec. 4. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict  
7 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for  
8 the biennium.
