A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to merged area schools, providing for the
2 appropriation and payment of state aid, and providing
3 for tuition.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the department of public instruction for each
3 fiscal year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and end-
4 ing June 30, 1975, the following amounts, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

7 fined in section two hundred eighty A point two (280A.2) of
8 the Code.

 14 the approval of the state board of public instruction
 15 reallocate from line item appropriations as provided in section
 16 one (1) of this Act, funds as circumstances require among
 17 the merged area schools limited to a reduction of not more
 18 than one percent from each of the merged areas.

19 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the general fund of
 20 the state to the department of public instruction for each
 21 year of the fiscal biennium commencing July 1, 1973 and end-
 22 ing June 30, 1975 the sum of two hundred thousand (200,000)
 23 dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be allo-
 24 cated to merged area schools for equipment replacement.

20 tion for residents of Iowa shall not exceed the lowest tui-
21 tion rate per semester, or the equivalent, charged by an in-
22 stitution of higher education under the state board of re-
23 gents for a full-time resident student. However, if a local
24 school district pays tuition for a resident pupil of high
25 school age, the limitation on tuition for residents of Iowa
26 shall not apply, the amount of tuition shall be determined
27 by the board of directors of the area school with the consent
28 of the local school board, and the pupil shall not be in-
29 cluded in the full-time equivalent enrollment of the area
30 school for the purpose of computing general aid to the area
31 school. Tuition for nonresidents of Iowa shall be not less
32 than one hundred fifty percent and not more than two hundred
33 percent of the tuition established for residents of Iowa.
34 Tuition for resident or nonresident students may be set at
35 a higher figure with the approval of the state board. A lower

1 tuition for nonresidents may be permitted under a reciprocal
2 tuition agreement between a merged area and an educational
3 institution in another state, if the agreement is approved
4 by the state board.

5 Sec. 12. Section two hundred eighty-two point six (282.6),

8 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. This section shall not apply
9 to tuition authorized by chapter two hundred eighty A (280A)

11 EXPLANATION

12 Under present law, an area school can't charge any tui-
13 tion for a student under age 21 unless he is a high school
14 graduate. This discourages area schools from educating high
15 school dropouts. Even more seriously, it prevents coopera-
16 tive programs for high school students. Many high school
17 students could benefit by taking some area school vocational
18 or college courses, with the local school district paying
19 tuition, but this can't be done under the present law.

20 H.F. 359 (now signed into law) corrects half of this prob-
21 lem. It provides that resident pupils of high school age
22 for which the local school district pays tuition to attend
23 an Iowa area school shall be counted in the local district's
24 enrollment for purposes of state aid. The local district
25 will get full state aid for a full-time student and can then
26 pay tuition for him to attend an area school.

27 Sections 10 through 12 of this bill correct the other half
28 of the problem by allowing the area school to charge tuition
29 if it is paid by the local school district. The present tui-
30 tion limit would not apply, because the local district's to-
31 tal funds per pupil are substantially larger than the present
32 area school tuition limit (equal to lowest tuition at any
33 Regents university). If the area school board sets tuition
34 too high, the local district board does not have to agree
35 to it. This means that the tuition will be negotiated between

1 the area school board and the local district board.
2 The student for whom the local district pays tuition will
3 not be counted in determining the area school's state aid.

Area Schools

In making its recommendation, the committee decided to emphasize vocational education, both in existing and new programs. The committee decided not to fund the new category of "career education" programs, and instead allocated the money that had been budgeted by the Governor for "career education" to the general aid and vocational education appropriations. \$2,000,000 for 1973-74 and \$2,500,000 for 1974-75 had been recommended by the Governor for "career education" programs.

The committee recommendation added \$179,000 to the general aid appropriation for 1973-74 for additional IPERS cost.

The \$2,000,000 for 1973-74 that had been recommended by the Governor for "career education" programs was reallocated as follows: \$775,000 was added to the Governor's general aid recommendation, and \$1,025,000 was added to the Governor's vocational education recommendation, to maintain existing programs and fund new or expanded programs.

The \$2,500,000 for 1974-75 that had been recommended by the Governor for "career education" programs was also reallocated as follows: \$819,000 was added to the Governor's general aid recommendation, and \$1,481,000 was added to the Governor's vocational education recommendation, to maintain existing programs and fund new or expanded programs.

The \$200,000 recommended in section three is allocated for the replacement of instructional equipment in vocational and technical courses.
