1 Section 1. For the state board of regents and institu-
 2 tions under the board of regents there is appropriated from
 3 the general fund of the state for the biennium beginning July
 4 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975, the following amounts,

13 appropriated by paragraph a of subsection two (2) of section
14 one (1), and paragraph a of subsection three (3) of section
15 one (1), of this Act among the institutions under its juris-
16 diction as long as the reallocation does not exceed the grand
17 total figure appropriated to the state board of regents by
18 this Act.

19 Sec. 3. It is the intent of the general assembly in mak-
20 ing appropriations pursuant to this Act, that the funds
21 available under the provisions of this Act shall be used to
22 pay salaries and other employee expenses for fifteen thousand
23 two hundred employees in the general program operations of
24 the institutions under the control of the state board of
25 regents for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1973
26 and ending June 30, 1975. A variance of one percent in the
27 number of employees is considered to be reasonable.

28 Sec. 4. The basic undergraduate resident student tuition
29 fee for all institutions of higher education under the control
30 of the state board of regents shall not be increased by more
31 than fifty dollars per academic year during the period of
32 July 1, 1973 to June 30, 1975. The basic nonresident student
33 tuition fee at the state university of Iowa shall not be in-
34 creased more than four hundred dollars per academic year dur-
35 ing the period of July 1, 1973 to June 30, 1975. The basic

1 nonresident student tuition fee at the university of northern
2 Iowa and at Iowa state university of science and technology
3 shall not be increased more than three hundred dollars per
4 academic year during the period of July 1, 1973 to June 30,
5 1975.

6 Sec. 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
7 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
8 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
9 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
10 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and
11 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all
12 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
13 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
14 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
15 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
16 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
17 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

18 Sec. 6. The state board of regents or any institution
19 under its control, or the governor and state comptroller,
20 are authorized to obtain federal grants to be expended in
21 connection with the operation of state board of regents in-
22 stitutions. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
23 of the state board of regents or any of its institutions are
24 appropriated for the purpose set forth in such federal grants
25 and receipts.

26 Sec. 7. When any laws of this state are in conflict with
27 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
28 biennium.

29 Sec. 8. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
30 for capital improvements.

Board of Regents

The Governor recommended salary increases of 5 percent for the fiscal year 1973-74 above the salary budget of fiscal year 1972-73. The committee recommendation is the same as the Governor's. The Governor also recommended salary increases of nine-tenths of a percent for fiscal year 1975 over the salary budget of fiscal year 1974. The committee recommendation does not include these funds since the committee intends to make that determination in the 1974 legislative session. The committee intends that salary increases for the second year of the biennium be funded from reversions in the same manner that salary increases for other departments and agencies have been funded.

The committee recommendation lists the category of repairs, replacements, and alterations as a separate item. Again, the committee endorses the Governor's recommendation, but lists it as a separate item to show the committee's concern that the repairs, replacements, and alterations money be spent for that purpose and none other.

The Governor's budget was formulated on the assumption that the number of students would remain constant throughout the biennium. The committee endorses this assumption. However, it feels that if there is a decline in the number of students the universities should have a corresponding re-trenchment in their operation, particularly in the number of employees.

The committee recommendation approves all of the Board of Regents "Special Needs" that were recommended by the Governor. By endorsing the Governor's recommendations, the committee also endorsed the deletions made by the Governor from the Regents request for "Special Needs." An itemization of the "Special Needs" that were approved by the committee are on file in the office of the Legislative Fiscal Director.

The general expense, equipment, and library books categories were funded at 100 percent of the Regents request. It is the committee's intent that any unused funds from these categories be reverted for the purpose of salary increases for fiscal year 1975.

Included in the committee's recommendation for the University Hospital is the intent that each county's indigent quota not be reduced during the biennium.

The committee recommendation places a limit on the number of employees. This number is the same as suggested in the Governor's proposed bill, and to this extent the committee endorses the Governor's suggestion.
