A BILL FOR

1 An Act to make an appropriation from the general fund of the
2 state to the civil rights commission.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1973 and
3 ending June 30, 1974, for the civil rights commission, the
4 following amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
5 to be used in the manner designated:

11 Sec. 2. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
12 for capital improvements.

13 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
14 of the agency receiving funds under this Act are appropriated
15 for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

16 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
17 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
18 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
19 the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1973 shall, on August 31,
20 1974, revert to the state treasury and to the credit of the
21 fund from which appropriated. In all other respects the
22 provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the
23 Code shall apply to appropriations made for the 1973-74 fiscal
24 year.

25 Sec. 5. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict
26 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for
27 the 1973-74 fiscal year.

30 The committee's recommendation is for an appropriation of \$187,350
for 1973-74
31 From this total, \$141,620 for 1973-74 is appropriated for salaries.
\$11,700 for 1973-74 is appropriated for travel.
32 \$20,210 for 1973-74 is appropriated for office supplies and expense,
printing and binding, telephone and telegraph, and equipment.
33 Other expenses, which include commission per diem and hearing expenses,
are appropriated at \$14,000 for 1973-74.
34 The committee's recommendation allows for an addition of two Field
Representatives, one Accounting Technician, one State Coordinator, one
35 Education Director, and one Information Specialist.
The subcommittee plans to hear the Civil Rights Commission next
session to determine the effect on the administration by the addition of
these six positions. A recommendation for fiscal year 1975 will be made
at that time.

5 members as the council deems appropriate to study the present
6 statutory duties of the civil rights commission, and what

8 dures by which these duties are discharged and to determine
9 whether the commission's staff and funding are sufficient,
10 excessive or deficient to enable the commission to properly
