## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act making an appropriation to the Iowa development com-
- 2 mission for the purpose of purchasing certain real property.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state to the Iowa development commission for the fiscal  
3 biennium commencing July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975,  
4 the sum of three hundred thousand (300,000) dollars, or so  
5 much thereof as may be necessary, for the purchase of real  
6 property to be used in the manner and under conditions set  
7 forth in this Act.

8 Sec. 2. The moneys appropriated by this Act, or so much  
9 thereof as may be necessary, shall be made available to the  
10 city of Ames, Iowa, at such time as it is certified to the  
11 director of the Iowa development commission and the state  
12 comptroller that the following conditions have been met:

13 1. The United States department of agriculture has agreed  
14 it will continue and will expand the veterinary biologics  
15 facility at Ames, Iowa, on real property purchased through  
16 funds appropriated by this Act and pursuant to conditions  
17 set forth in this Act.

18 2. The city of Ames, Iowa certifies that the sum of one  
19 hundred thousand (100,000) dollars is available from private  
20 sources and will be used in purchasing real property to be  
21 used by the United States department of agriculture in  
22 continuing and expanding the veterinary biologics facility.

23 3. That if the property to be purchased is no longer  
24 used as the site for the veterinary biologics facility title  
25 to the property will revert to the state of Iowa.

26 Sec. 3. The Iowa development commission shall oversee  
27 and be privy to negotiations between the United States depart-  
28 ment of agriculture and the city of Ames, Iowa in order to  
29 protect the interests of the state. The director of the Iowa  
30 development commission shall make periodic reports to the  
31 state comptroller and the governor relating to the negoti-  
32 ations and conditions established in this Act.
