- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Amend House File 792 as follows:

- 2 1. Page 2, by inserting the following section after line 30:
- 3 Sec. \_\_\_\_ . Section six hundred five point two (605.2),
- 4 Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 605.2 EXPENSES. Where a judge of the district or
- 6 supreme court is required, in the discharge of his official
- 7 duties, to leave the county of his residence or leave the city
- 8 or town of his residence to perform such duties, he shall be
- 9 paid such actual and necessary expenses for living quarters
- 10 and living expenses not to exceed the sum of ~~fifteen~~ twenty
- 11 dollars per day and transportation expenses as shall be
- 12 incurred.
- 13 2. By renumbering the remaining sections to conform with this
- 14 amendment.

- 9 actual and necessary expenses for living quarters and living

- 11 day and transportation expenses as shall be incurred.

31 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
32 of the courts receiving funds under this Act are appropriated  
33 for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

34 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used  
35 for capital improvements.

1     Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
 2 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
 3 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
 4 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973  
 5 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and  
 6 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all  
 7 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-  
 8 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made  
 9 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered  
 10 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second  
 11 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight  
 12 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

13     Sec. 5. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict  
 14 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for  
 15 the biennium.

The committee's recommendation is for an appropriation for salaries and benefits of \$3,676,373 for 1973-74 and \$3,695,805 for 1974-75 to be spent as follows:
