A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation to the budget and financial
2 control committee or its successor committee.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for each fiscal year of the biennium commencing
3 July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975 to the budget and fi-
4 nancial control committee or its successor committee, the
5 following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
6 to be used for the following purposes:

9 For members' per diem and ex-
10 penses in the amounts provided
11 for in chapter two (2) of the
12 Code, and for carrying out the
13 duties of the committee, as well
14 as other administrative expense,
15 as authorized by law, not other-
16 wise provided by an enactment of
17 the Sixty-fifth General Assembly,

19 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
20 of the department are appropriated for the purpose set forth
21 in such federal grants or receipts.

22 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
23 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
24 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
25 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
26 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and
27 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all
28 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
29 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
30 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
31 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
32 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
33 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

34 Sec. 4. When any of the laws of this state are in con-
35 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern
36 for the biennium.
