## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 A Joint Resolution to approve contracting for cost analyses
- 2 of no-fault motor vehicle insurance legislation.
- 3 WHEREAS, legislation relating to no-fault motor vehicle
- 4 insurance is under consideration by both houses of the gen-
- 5 eral assembly; and
- 6 WHEREAS, meaningful consideration cannot be given to these
- 7 measures without reliable studies of their projected effects
- 8 on the cost of motor vehicle insurance; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the Ford Foundation and the United States Depart-
- 10 ment of Transportation have made arrangements for providing
- 11 cost analyses of no-fault insurance proposals to states re-
- 12 questing such service at a reasonable cost through a grant
- 13 to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners to
- 14 retain consulting actuaries Milliman and Robertson, Inc. of
- 15 Chicago, Illinois, NOW THEREFORE,
- 16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
- 17 Section 1. There is appropriated to the legislative ser-
- 18 vice bureau from the general fund of the state commencing
- 19 with the effective date of this Act, the sum of eight thou-
- 20 sand (8,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
- 21 to be used to contract with the firm of Milliman and Robert-
- 22 son, Inc. of Chicago, Illinois, to provide detailed cost
- 23 analyses of legislation relating to no-fault motor vehicle
- 24 insurance including the cost analyses of alternative approaches
- 25 thereto. The chairmen of the committees on commerce, in con-

1 sultation with the commissioner of insurance, shall negotiate  
2 the terms of the contract with Milliman and Robertson, Inc.,  
3 and shall make a report of those negotiations to the commit-  
4 tees on commerce. The legislative service bureau shall make  
5 payments of the funds appropriated by this Act pursuant to  
6 the contract approved. A report of the results of the study  
7 shall be made to the general assembly.

8 Sec. 2. Any unencumbered funds not expended as provided  
9 in this Act shall revert to the general fund of the state  
10 on September 30, 1973.

11 Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
12 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-  
13 tion in Times-Democrat, a newspaper published  
14 in Davenport, Iowa, and in The Allison Tribune,  
15 a newspaper published in Allison, Iowa.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This resolution appropriates eight thousand dollars to  
18 the legislative service bureau for the purpose of contracting  
19 with a consulting actuarial firm to provide cost studies of  
20 no-fault motor vehicle legislation pending in the general  
21 assembly and alternative approaches thereto. The chairmen  
22 of the committees on commerce are charged with negotiating  
23 the terms of the contracts in consultation with the commis-  
24 sioner of insurance.
