A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to used car dealer lists.
2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
3 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point seventy
4 (321.70), unnumbered paragraph two (2), Code 1973, is amended
5 to read as follows:
6 Dealers registered under the provisions of this chapter
7 shall, on or before ~~July-5~~ August first of each year, furnish
8 the county treasurer and the department with a list of all
9 used trucks, truck tractors, road tractors, trailers and
10 semitrailers held by them for sale or trade, and on which
11 the second installment of the current annual registration
12 fee has not been paid, and the payment of the second install-
13 ment shall then be waived, subject to the reregistration of
14 such vehicle under the provisions of section 321.106 at such
15 time as a dealer ceases to hold any such vehicle for sale or
16 trade.

EXPLANATION

18 This bill changes the date from July 5 to August 1 when used
19 car dealers must furnish the county treasurer a list of certain
20 used motor vehicles upon which the second installment of the
21 current annual registration fee has not been paid.

1 Amend Senate File 1113, page 1, by adding the
2 following section after line 16:

3 Sec. _____. NEW SECTION. The use of a dealer
4 identification sticker, tag, plate, or other device
5 affixed to a new or used motor vehicle is hereby pro-
6 hibited. As used in this section "dealer identifica-
7 tion sticker, tag, plate, or other device" means
8 any device affixed to a new or used motor vehicle
9 which identifies the dealer from whom the motor
10 vehicle was purchased. Any dealer violating the pro-
11 visions of this section shall be subject to a fine
12 not exceeding twenty-five dollars; each motor vehicle
13 which has a dealer identification sticker, tag, plate
14 or device affixed to it shall constitute a separate
15 offense.
