12 Sec. 2. The funds appropriated by this Act are in addition to

15 Sec. 3. The funds appropriated by subsections three (3) and
16 four (4) of section one (1) of this Act shall be available on
17 January 1, 1975 only if federal matching funds for funds appro-
18 priated by the Acts of the Sixty-fourth General Assembly, 1972
19 Session, chapter one thousand fifteen (1015), section one (1),
20 subsection three (3) are not available on such date.

21 Sec. 4. Unencumbered funds appropriated by subsections one
22 (1) and two (2) of section one (1) of this Act shall revert to
23 the general fund of the state on June 30, 1976 and unencumbered
24 funds appropriated by subsections three (3) and four (4) of
25 section one (1) of this Act shall revert to the general fund of
26 the state on June 30, 1977. In all other respects not provided
27 for in this Act, the provisions of the Acts of the Sixty-fourth

30 Sec. 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Acts of the

33 (67,000) dollars of funds appropriated for the 1973-74 fiscal
34 year pursuant to subsection two (2) of the Acts of the Sixty-
35 fifth General Assembly, 1973 Session, chapter one hundred (100),

1 shall not revert on August 31, 1974 but shall be available for
2 expenditure for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1974.

3 Sec. 6. It is the intent of the general assembly that funds
4 appropriated pursuant to this Act are necessary for and shall be
5 used to complete the educational radio and television transmitter
6 requirements in order to provide statewide coverage of educational
7 radio and television programming. The general assembly acknowl-
8 edges that translators may later be necessary to supplement the
9 transmitters provided for in this Act.
