1 Section 1. There is appropriated to the Iowa commission for
2 the blind from the general fund of the state, the sum of one
3 hundred forty thousand (140,000) dollars, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, to be used for remodeling and repairs of the
5 Iowa commission for the blind building.

6 Sec. 2. Contracts for improvements for which funds are
7 appropriated by this Act shall be submitted by the Iowa commis-
8 sion for the blind to the governor and the state comptroller
9 for approval, except that items commonly known as change orders
10 need not be submitted to the governor and the state comptroller
11 unless such change orders actually increase the total cost of
12 that particular project.

13 Sec. 3. The Iowa commission for the blind, the governor and
14 the state comptroller are authorized to obtain and accept federal
15 grants to the state to be used in connection with the funds
16 appropriated in this Act and other available federal funds.

17 Sec. 4. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30,
18 1977 of the appropriation of this Act shall revert to the
19 general fund of the state as of September 30, 1977.

20 Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
21 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-
22 tion in the Jackson Sentinel, a newspaper published in
23 Maquoketa, Iowa, and in The Mount Vernon Hawkeye-Record and
24 The Lisbon Herald, a newspaper published in Mount Vernon, Iowa.
