2 academy council and making an appropriation.

1 Section 1. Section eighty B point six (80B.6), Code
2 1973, is amended by striking the section and inserting in
3 lieu thereof the following:

4 80B.6 COUNCIL CREATED--MEMBERSHIP. There is hereby
5 created the Iowa law enforcement academy council which shall
6 consist of the following members:

7 1. The attorney general, or his designated representative.

8 2. Two members of the senate, not more than one of whom
9 will be from the same political party, appointed by the
10 lieutenant governor for a term of four years commencing on
11 August 15, 1974.

12 3. Two members of the house of representatives, not more
13 than one of whom will be from the same political party, ap-
14 pointed by the speaker of the house for a term of two years
15 commencing on August 15, 1974.

16 4. Two members appointed by the governor with the consent
17 of the senate. One member shall be appointed by the governor
18 for a term of four years commencing on August 15, 1974. One
19 member shall be appointed by the governor for a term of two
20 years commencing on August 15, 1974. All succeeding appoint-
21 ments by the governor shall be for a term of four years.

22 5. One member, knowledgeable in law enforcement, appointed
23 by the superintendent of public instruction from an area
24 school for a term of two years commencing on August 15, 1974.
25 All succeeding appointments by the superintendent of public
26 instruction shall be for a term of four years.

27 6. One member from the higher education facilities com-
28 mission for a term of four years commencing on August 15,
29 1974. This member shall be the commissioner who represents
30 the private colleges.

31 7. One member appointed by the commissioner of social
32 services from the division of adult corrections for a term
33 of two years commencing on August 15, 1974. All succeeding
34 appointments by the commissioner of social services shall be
35 for a term of four years.

1 8. One member appointed by the commissioner of public
2 safety from the department of public safety for a term of
3 four years commencing on August 15, 1974.

4 9. One member elected by the state board of regents for
5 a term of four years commencing August 15, 1974.

6 In the event a member appointed pursuant to this section
7 is unable to complete his term, the vacancy shall be filled
8 for the unexpired term in the same manner as the original
9 appointment.

10 Sec. 2. Section eighty B point eight (80B.8), Code 1973,
11 as amended by Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1973
12 Session, chapter one hundred twenty-four (124), section five
13 (5), is amended to read as follows:

14 80B.8 COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. The members of the
15 council, who are not employees of the state or a political
16 subdivision, shall be paid a forty dollar per diem ~~and.~~ All
17 members of the council shall be reimbursed for necessary and
18 actual expenses incurred in attending meetings and in the
19 performance of their duties. All per diem and expense moneys
20 paid to members shall be paid from funds appropriated to the
21 Iowa law enforcement academy.

22 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the general fund of
23 the state to the Iowa law enforcement academy the sum of one
24 hundred thousand (100,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may
25 be necessary to be used to pay the tuition of selected law
26 enforcement academy recruits assigned to an approved law en-
27 forcement training facility for training by the Iowa law en-
28 forcement academy.

29 Sec. 4. It is the intent of the general assembly that the
30 funds appropriated by this Act be used by the Iowa law enforce-
31 ment academy to allow selected law enforcement recruits to
32 attend approved law enforcement training facilities and, thus,
33 reduce the number of recruits waiting to receive training at
34 the Iowa law enforcement academy. The Iowa law enforcement
35 academy in cooperation with the approved law enforcement

1 training facilities shall select the recruits to be assigned
2 to law enforcement training facilities from the list of those
3 recruits awaiting training at the Iowa law enforcement academy.

4 EXPLANATION

5 This bill provides for a change in the make-up of the Iowa
6 law enforcement academy council, prohibits state employees
7 from receiving per diem while a member of the council, and
8 makes an appropriation to the Iowa law enforcement academy
9 for the purpose of assigning recruits to regional law enforce-
10 ment academies and paying their tuition.
