A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the disposition of intoxicating liquors.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section seven hundred fifty-one point thirty-
2 one (751.31), Code 1973, is amended by striking subsection
3 one (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following new sub-
4 sections:

5 NEW SUBSECTION. By ordering that forfeited intoxicating
6 liquors, which have a valid unbroken federal liquor tax stamp
7 properly affixed to the vessel and which the magistrate has
8 no reason to believe is adulterated or contaminated, be de-
9 livered to the Iowa beer and liquor control department.

10 NEW SUBSECTION. By ordering the destruction of forfeited
11 intoxicating liquors which do not have a valid federal liquor
12 tax stamp properly affixed to the vessel or which the magistrate
13 has reason to believe is contaminated or adulterated.

14 Sec. 2. Section one hundred twenty-three point twenty
15 (123.20), Code 1973, is amended by adding the following new
16 subsection:

17 NEW SUBSECTION. To accept intoxicating liquors ordered
18 delivered to the Iowa beer and liquor control department
19 pursuant to section one (1) of this Act and offer such in-
20 toxicating liquors for sale through the state liquor stores,
21 unless the director determines that such intoxicating liquors
22 may be adulterated or contaminated. If the director deter-
23 mines that such intoxicating liquors may be adulterated or
24 contaminated he shall order their destruction.

25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill provides that forfeited intoxicating liquors
27 may be delivered to the Iowa beer and liquor control depart-
28 ment for sale in state liquor stores.
