A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the Iowa soldiers home.
2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Chapter two hundred nineteen (219), Code 1973,
2 is amended by adding sections two (2) through five (5) of
3 this Act.

4 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. The Iowa soldiers home may file
5 claims for reimbursement of per diem expenses for veterans
6 as authorized under the United States Code, Title thirty-eight
7 (38), sections six hundred forty-one (641) through six hundred
8 forty-three (643), inclusive. The claims shall be filed quar-
9 terly or as otherwise authorized by the administrator, United
10 States veterans administration.

11 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. There is created in the state
12 treasury an Iowa soldiers home fund, the proceeds of which
13 shall be used by the department of social services solely
14 to carry out the provisions of this Act. All receipts from
15 the claims filed under section two (2) of this Act shall be
16 forwarded to the treasurer of state and deposited by him in
17 the Iowa soldiers home fund.

18 The unencumbered balance in the Iowa soldiers home fund
19 shall not exceed two million five hundred thousand dollars
20 at any time and any amount exceeding two million five hundred
21 thousand dollars in the fund at any time shall be credited
22 to the general fund of the state of Iowa.

23 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. The moneys in the Iowa soldiers
24 home fund are appropriated to the Iowa soldiers home for the
25 construction of new buildings, the expansion, remodeling,
26 repair, modification, or alteration of existing buildings,
27 and to provide equipment for such buildings. The moneys may
28 also be used as matching funds for federal grants made to
29 this state for new buildings and equipment at the Iowa soldiers
30 home.

31 The expenditure of any money from the Iowa soldiers home
32 fund shall be approved by the executive council.

33 Sec. 5. The provisions of this Act shall become void after
34 June 30, 1988.

EXPLANATION

1
 2 This bill authorizes the Iowa Soldiers Home to file claims
 3 with the United States Veterans Administration for reimburse-
 4 ment of per diem expenses as authorized under United States
 5 Code, Title 38, Sections 641 through 643, for providing care
 6 and health services to Iowa's aged, ill, or chronically ill
 7 veterans. It also provides for the transmittal of such pay-
 8 ments to the treasurer of state for deposit in the Iowa
 9 Soldiers Home Fund and for appropriation of same for a build-
 10 ing improvement and construction program at the Iowa Soldiers
 11 Home.

12 The unencumbered balance in the Iowa Soldiers Home Fund
 13 is not to exceed two million five hundred thousand dollars
 14 at any time for this capital improvement program.

15 The Act will be void after June 30, 1988.

Prepared in regard to S.F. 184 - An Act relating to the
 Iowa Soldiers Home. Following is the fiscal effect in
 dollars of the legislative proposal as required by Senate
 Rule 31.

The per diem expenses which the United States Veterans
 Administration reimburses the Iowa Soldiers' Home for pro-
 viding care and health services to Iowa's aged, ill or
 chronically ill veterans is currently being deposited to the
 State General Fund.

It is estimated that the implementation of this Act
 would reduce revenue to the State General Fund by
 approximately \$600,000 per year for each of the next five
 years.

1 Amend Senate File 184 as amended and passed by
2 the Senate as follows:
3 1. By striking all after the enacting clause and
4 inserting in lieu thereof the following:
5 Section 1. There is appropriated to the department
6 of social services from the general fund of the state
7 the sum of two million two hundred thousand (2,200,000)
8 dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be
9 applied to the cost of constructing at the Iowa
10 soldiers home a one-hundred-eighty bed nursing care
11 facility, and the necessary preparation of the site
12 for the nursing care facility. The funds appropriated
13 to the department by this Act shall be used only to
14 match federal funds which are or may become available
15 to pay a portion of the cost of constructing the
16 nursing care facility authorized by this Act.
17 Sec. 2. Fees for architectural services shall
18 be paid only for those services relating to the
19 general contract for the actual construction of a
20 building. It is the intent of this section that no
21 fees shall be paid for architectural services relating
22 to interior furniture, decorating, or other things not
23 a part of the building.
24 Sec. 3. The appropriation made by this Act shall
25 not be subject to reversion as provided by section
