A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act to make a supplemental appropriation from moneys received
- 2 by the board of nursing examiners.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT (Senate File 231)

Line fourteen (14) of Senate File 231, by appropriating an additional \$10,835 to the Board of Nursing Examiners, corrects a shortage which developed from having more applicants take the test than was anticipated and appropriated for. The fees collected from those who took the exam went into the trust fund and cannot be spent by the Board without legislative approval.

The expense for the "Commission to Study Nursing in Iowa," which has been appointed by the Governor, was projected in the 1973-74 Departmental Budget Request. To allow the Commission to begin in the present fiscal year, line twenty-one (21) of Senate File 231 appropriates \$17,600. The Board's 1973-74 askings will be reduced accordingly.

24 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight point
 25 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, the unencumbered or unobligated
 26 balances of moneys appropriated by this Act for the governor's
 27 commission to study nursing in Iowa shall revert to the nurses'
 28 fund under section one hundred forty-seven point one hundred
 29 seven (147.107) of the Code on July 1, 1974.

30 Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
 31 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication
 32 in the Times-Democrat, ^{4/6/73 (992)} a newspaper published in Davenport, Iowa,
 33 and in The Maquoketa Community Press, ^{4/10/73 (992)} a newspaper published in
 34 Maquoketa, Iowa.
