A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to bond elections for joint city-county
2 buildings.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. NEW SECTION. When bonds which require a vote
5 of the people are to be issued for financing joint facili-
6 ties of a county and one or more cities or towns within the
7 county, pursuant to an agreement made under the authority of
8 chapter twenty-eight E (28E) of the Code, or pursuant to
9 other provisions of law, the board of supervisors and the
10 council of each city and town shall arrange for a single
11 election on the question of issuing the bonds, but if the
12 county and the cities or towns are proposing to make separate
13 bond issues, the ballot shall contain separate questions,
14 one to be voted upon by all voters of the county, and one
15 or more to be voted upon only by the voters of the city or
16 town which is to make a separate bond issue.

EXPLANATION

17
18 The purpose of this bill is to prevent the need for two
19 separate elections when a bond issue for joint facilities of
20 a county and city or town is proposed. However, if there
21 will be separate bond issues by the county and the cities
22 or towns involved, the ballot shall list separate questions
23 to be voted upon by the appropriate voters.
