### A BILL FOR

1 An Act to provide copies of the Iowa Code to city assessors  
2 without cost.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Section sixteen point twenty-four (16.24),  
5 subsection sixteen (16), Code 1973, is amended to read as  
6 follows:

7 16. To the clerk of the district court, the county attor-  
8 ney, the county auditor, the county recorder, county and city  
9 assessor, the county treasurer, the sheriff, and the county  
10 superintendent of each county in the state and also for use  
11 in each courtroom of the district court . . . . 1 copy

#### EXPLANATION

13 Under the present law, the superintendent of printing is  
14 required to furnish a copy of the Iowa Code to county asses-  
15 sors, while city assessors are required to purchase the Code.  
16 This bill provides that a free copy of the Iowa Code will  
17 be provided to all assessors, city and county.

Prepared in regard to S.F. 39 - A Bill for an Act to provide copies of the Iowa Code to city assessors without cost. Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal as required by Senate Rule 31.

It appears the state would expend \$900 (1) to provide city assessors throughout the state with free copies of the 1973 Iowa Code.
