1 An Act making an appropriation to the state comptroller for
2 payment of certain publication costs of the Iowa academy
3 of science.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for each year of the biennium beginning July
3 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975, to the state comptroller
4 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be neces-
5 sary, to be used in the manner designated:

11 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
12 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
13 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
14 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
15 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and
16 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all
17 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
18 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
19 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
20 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
21 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
22 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

23 Sec. 3. When any provisions of the laws of this state
24 are in conflict with this Act, the provisions of this Act
25 shall govern for the biennium.

26 Sec. 4. No funds appropriated by this Act shall be used
27 for capital improvements.

28 EXPLANATION

29 This bill appropriates \$16,000 to the Iowa Academy of
30 Science.
