2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

5 The committee recommendation is for an appropriation of \$2,780.00 for
6 1973-74 and \$2,730.00 for 1974-75, to be used for support, maintenance, and
7 miscellaneous purposes.

Mississippi River Parkway Commission

8 The committee recommendation is for an appropriation of \$8,500.00 for
9 1973-74 and \$5,800.00 for 1974-75.

10 From this total, \$5,600.00 for 1973-74 and \$3,100.00 for 1974-75 is appro-
11 priated for travel.

12 \$1,000.00 for 1973-74 and \$750.00 for 1974-75 is appropriated for office
13 supplies and expense, printing and binding, and telephone.

14 \$2,000.00 for 1973-74 and \$2,000.00 for 1974-75 is appropriated for national
15 es.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the Herbert Hoover Birthplace Foundation,
3 Incorporated, and the Mississippi river parkway commission
4 for each fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
5 and ending June 30, 1975, the following amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the manner desig-

18 Sec. 2. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
19 for capital improvements. Any balance remaining in the funds
20 for which appropriations are made by this Act at the end of
21 the first fiscal year of the biennium shall carry forward
22 to the second fiscal year of the biennium.

23 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
24 of the agencies receiving funds under this Act are appropriated
25 for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.
