- 1 An Act to appropriate from moneys received by the Iowa
- 2 aeronautics commission.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

REPORT OF HOUSE COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS

(Senate File 499)

Aeronautics Commission

(Trust)

The committee recommendation is for a budget of \$222,978.00 for 1973-74 and \$217,886.00 for 1974-75, to be used for administrative purposes.

From this total, \$149,480.00 for 1973-74 and \$152,790.00 for 1974-75 is budgeted for salaries.

\$14,371.00 for 1973-74 and \$10,209.00 for 1974-75 is budgeted for travel.

\$10,941.00 for 1973-74 and \$11,581.00 for 1974-75 is budgeted for office supplies and expense.

\$16,990.00 for 1973-74 and \$11,930.00 for 1974-75 is budgeted for printing and binding and telephone and telegraph.

Other expenses, which include equipment, miscellaneous office expense, office rent and utilities, and education material, are budgeted at \$30,686.00 for 1973-74 and \$31,376.00 for 1974-75.

The committee recommendation allows for no increase in personnel.

1 Section 1. For the Iowa aeronautics commission, there
2 is appropriated all funds received in the state aviation fund
3 under authority of chapter three hundred twenty-eight (328)
4 of the Code, for each fiscal year of the biennium, beginning
5 July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975. The following amounts,
6 or so much thereof as may be necessary, are authorized to
7 be expended from said receipts to be used for the following
8 purposes, to wit:

15 Sec. 2. The remainder of the state aviation fund is ap-
16 propriated for contingencies arising during the biennium which
17 are legally payable from the fund and for aeronautical purposes
18 authorized by section three hundred twenty-eight point twelve
19 (328.12) of the Code.

20 Sec. 3. A contingency shall not include any purpose or
21 project which was presented to the general assembly or any
22 standing committee or subcommittee of a standing committee
23 by any person by way of a bill, proposed bill, amendment to
24 a bill, written document, or a proposal which is documented
25 by the minutes, records, or reports of a committee or
26 subcommittee, and which failed to be enacted into law; however,
27 for the purpose of this Act a necessity of additional operating
28 funds may be construed as a contingency.

29 Before any of the funds authorized to be expended by this
30 Act shall be allocated for contingencies, it shall be deter-
31 mined by the executive council that a contingency exists and
32 that the contingency was neither existent while the general
33 assembly was in session nor reasonably foreseeable at that
34 time, and that the proposed allocation shall be for the best
35 interest of the state.

1 If a contingency arises or could reasonably be foreseen
2 during the time the general assembly is in session, expendi-
3 tures for the contingency must be authorized by the general
4 assembly.

5 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
6 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
7 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
8 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
9 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and
10 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all
11 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
12 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
13 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
14 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
15 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
16 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

17 Sec. 5. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
18 of the aeronautics commission are appropriated for the pur-
19 pose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

20 Sec. 6. Where any laws of this state are in conflict with
21 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
22 biennium.
