The committee recommendation is for an appropriation of \$150,000.00 for 1973-74 and \$150,000.00 for 1974-75 from the primary road fund to the Industrial Commission for payment of workmen's compensation claims of employees of the State Highway Commission.

The appropriated sums are estimated maximum figures deemed necessary, based on past experience.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the primary road
2 fund to the industrial commission for each year of the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975 the following
4 amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used
5 in the manner designated:

16 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
17 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
18 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
19 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
20 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and
21 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all
22 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
23 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
24 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
25 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
26 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
27 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

28 Sec. 3. When any provision of the laws of this state are
29 in conflict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall
30 govern for the biennium.
