A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation from the general fund to the
 2 state comptroller for the substitution or replacement, in
 3 whole or in part, of any federal funds which are not avail-
 4 able to the state for previously existing federal programs
 5 financed in whole or in part by federal funds during the
 6 period beginning July 1, 1972, and ending March 31, 1973.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the state comptroller from any funds of the
3 state not otherwise appropriated for the period beginning
4 April 1, 1973, and ending December 31, 1973, for the follow-
5 ing purpose:

6 To substitute for or replace, in whole or in part, any
7 federal funds which are not currently appropriated by the
8 federal government to the state, or otherwise not available
9 to the state by reason of federal executive action during
10 the period of this Act. The funds substituted or replaced
11 must be for previously existing federal programs financed
12 in whole or in part by federal funds during the period begin-
13 ning July 1, 1972, and ending March 31, 1973. The federal
14 programs include, but are not limited to, the programs
15 generally referred to as the summer youth program and the
16 day care facilities program.

17 Sec. 2. No appropriation made from this Act shall ex-
18 ceed the total amounts received or otherwise available to
19 the state from federal funds during the period beginning July
20 1, 1972, and ending March 31, 1973.

21 Sec. 3. No allocation shall be made from this Act with-
22 out the written certification of the state department head
23 of the department responsible for the federal funds affected.
24 The certification shall be made to the state comptroller
25 stating all information relative to the federal funds pre-
26 viously received, the status of existing federal funding
27 statutes or executive impoundments, the express purpose of
28 the programs and the effect on state funding and any other
29 pertinent information which may be requested by the state
30 comptroller. Copies of all such information and the certi-
31 fication shall be simultaneously filed with the legislative
32 fiscal director, and no funds shall be allocated by the comp-
33 troller for ten days following the receipt of the certifica-
34 tion.

35 Sec. 4. Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act

1 shall be expended, it shall be determined in writing by the
 2 governor to the comptroller that such expenditures are in
 3 the best interest of the state.

4 Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
 5 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publi-
 6 cation in the Waterloo Daily Courier, a newspaper published
 7 in Waterloo, Iowa, and in the Iowa City Press-Citizen, a
 8 newspaper published in Iowa City, Iowa.

10 The committee recommendation is for an appropriation of \$1,234,000 for
 11 the Governor's Youth Opportunity Program and \$579,000 for the Day Care
 12 Facilities Program for the fiscal biennium 1973-75.

13 The appropriation for the Governor's Youth Opportunity Program is
 14 based on the "Guidelines for Youth Employment Projects," dated May,
 15 1973, which is on file in the office of the Legislative Fiscal Director.

Prepared in regard to S.F. 513 - An Act making an appropriation from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the comptroller for the substitution or replacement, in whole or in part, of any federal funds which are not available to the state for previously existing federal programs financed in whole or in part by federal funds during the period July 1, 1972 and ending March 31, 1973, Cusack Amendment thereto. Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal as required by House Rule 48.
