A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation to the committee on employment
2 of the handicapped.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 (Senate File 523)

5 Governor's Committee on Employment of the Handicapped

6 The committee's recommendation is for a budget of \$76,950 for 1973-74
and \$79,650 for 1974-75.

7 From this total, \$65,840 for 1973-74 and \$67,600 for 1974-75 is for salaries.
8 This recommendation allows for the addition of one consultant for the handi-
capped and one housing consultant for the handicapped. A position of Clerk
9 II is eliminated, so the committee recommendation provides for an increase
of one position over the present level of five.

10 \$11,110 for 1973-74 and \$12,050 for 1974-75 is appropriated for travel,
office supplies and expense, telephone and telegraph, and equipment.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state of Iowa for the committee on employment of the
3 handicapped for each fiscal year of the biennium commencing
4 July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975, the following amounts,
5 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the
6 manner designated:

12 Sec. 2. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
13 for capital improvements.

14 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
15 of the agency receiving funds under this Act are appropriated
16 for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

17 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
18 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered
19 or unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act
20 for the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1,
21 1973 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury
22 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In
23 all other respects the provisions of section eight point
24 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations
25 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
26 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
27 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
28 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

29 Sec. 5. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict
30 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
31 biennium.
