A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state

2 for the Iowa commission for the blind.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state to the Iowa commission for the blind for each
 3 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1973 and ending June
 4 30, 1975, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may
 5 be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

18 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
 19 of the commission are appropriated for the purpose set forth
 20 in such federal grants or receipts.

21 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
 22 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
 23 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
 24 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
 25 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and
 26 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all
 27 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
 28 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
 29 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
 30 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
 31 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
 32 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

33 Sec. 4. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict
 34 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for
 35 the biennium.
