1 Amend Senate File 544, page 2, as follows:  
2 1. By striking lines 3 through 21, inclusive, and  
3 inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
4 "the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1974 and ending  
5 June 30, 1975 the sum of one hundred twenty-one thou-  
6 sand two hundred (121,200) dollars, or so much there-  
7 of as is necessary, to be used for salaries, support,  
8 maintenance and miscellaneous purposes.  
9 Sec. 2. Unencumbered funds remaining as of  
10 June 30, 1975 shall revert to the general fund of the  
11 state as of September 30, 1975."  
12 2. By renumbering the sections.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state to the public employment relations board for  
3 each fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973 and  
4 ending June 30, 1975, the following amounts, or so much there-  
5 of as may be necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

10 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
11 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
12 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
13 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973  
14 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and  
15 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all  
16 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-  
17 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made  
18 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered  
19 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second  
20 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight  
21 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

22 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used  
23 for capital improvements.

24 Sec. 4. When any of the laws of this state are in con-  
25 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern  
26 for the biennium.
