2 tax fund to the department of revenue.

The committee's recommendation is for an appropriation of \$966,409 for 1973-74 and \$991,837 for 1974-75.

9

From this total, \$494,679 for 1973-74 and \$509,487 for 1974-75 is appropriated for salaries.

10

\$93,930 for 1973-74 and \$90,650 for 1974-75 is appropriated for travel.

11

\$36,300 for 1973-74 and \$38,500 for 1974-75 is appropriated for office supplies and expense, printing and binding, telephone and telegraph, and equipment.

Other expenses, which include data processing equipment, insurance, postage, unemployment compensation, transfer out, and administration of use tax are appropriated at \$341,500 for 1973-74 and \$353,200 for 1974-75.

The committee's recommendation allows for no increase in personnel.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the motor vehicle
2 fuel tax fund for each fiscal year of the biennium beginning
3 July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975 to the department of
4 revenue the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

16 Sec. 2. The funds appropriated by this Act shall be seg-
17 regated and maintained in a separate account and used only
18 for the purposes of administering the provisions of chapter
19 three hundred twenty-four (324) of the Code.

20 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
21 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
22 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
23 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973
24 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and
25 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all
26 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
27 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
28 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
29 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
30 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
31 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

32 Sec. 4. Where any of the laws of this state are in con-
33 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern
34 for the biennium.
