## A BILL FOR

1 An Act setting the salary rate for state officials and  
2 designated employees of the state.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. The salary rates specified in this Act shall  
 2 be in effect for the fiscal biennium commencing July 1, 1973  
 3 and ending June 30, 1975 and for each fiscal year after the  
 4 fiscal year ending June 30, 1975 the salary rate shall be  
 5 the same as the rate specified for the fiscal year commencing  
 6 July 1, 1974 until otherwise provided by the general assembly.  
 7 Salaries provided for in this Act shall be paid from funds  
 8 appropriated to the department, agency, office, division,  
 9 commission, board, or other entity specified in this Act,  
 10 and pursuant to any Act of the general assembly making such  
 11 an appropriation.

12 The following annual salary rates shall be paid to the  
 13 person holding the position indicated from funds appropriated  
 14 by the general assembly for such purpose:

EXPLANATION

25 This Act sets the salaries of various state officers and  
26 employees. The Code of Iowa provides in some cases that the  
27 general assembly set the salaries of a state official. In  
28 other cases the Code provides that a board, department, com-  
29 mission, division, or committee hire a particular officer  
30 and set his salary, or the officer may serve at the pleasure  
31 of the appointing authority, be it the governor or other  
32 agency. In such case this Act provides a maximum limit for  
33 a salary rather than an exact amount for the salary as is  
34 the case for those officers for whom it is specified that  
35 the general assembly shall set the salary.

 30 and set his salary, or the officer may serve at the pleasure  
 31 of the appointing authority, be it the governor or other  
 32 agency. In such case this Act provides a maximum limit for  
 33 a salary rather than an exact amount for the salary as is  
 34 the case for those officers for whom it is specified that  
 35 the general assembly shall set the salary.
