1 Amend Senate File 597, as passed by the Senate,  
2 page 2, by striking lines 1 through 20, inclusive,  
3 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
4 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general  
5 fund of the state to the department of general ser-  
6 vices for the educational radio and television  
7 facility board for the fiscal year beginning July  
8 1, 1974 and ending June 30, 1975, the sum of one  
9 hundred thousand (100,000) dollars, or so much thereof  
10 as may be necessary, to be used for the acquisition  
11 of lighting equipment for studio production.  
12 Sec. 2. Unencumbered or unobligated funds appro-  
13 priated by this Act remaining as of June 30, 1975 shall  
14 revert to the general fund of the state on August  
15 31, 1975.

1 Section 1. For the department of general services for  
2 the educational radio and television facility board there  
3 is appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1973  
4 and ending June 30, 1974, the following amounts, or so much  
5 thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the following  
6 purposes:

9 1. For two video tape recorders:	\$ 195,000
10 2. For lighting equipment:	\$ 100,000
11 3. For a film changer:	\$ 88,000

12 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
13 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
14 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
15 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973  
16 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and  
17 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all  
18 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-  
19 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made  
20 for the first fiscal year of such biennium.

21 Sec. 3. The department of general services, the educa-  
22 tional radio and television facility board, the governor,  
23 and the state comptroller may obtain federal grants for the  
24 state to be used in connection with the funds appropriated  
25 by this Act.
