1 An Act relating to commitment of alcohol and drug addicts.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred twenty-four point one
2 (224.1), Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:

3 224.1 COMMITMENT. Persons addicted to the excessive use
4 of intoxicating liquors, morphine, cocaine, or other narcotic
5 drugs may be committed by the commissioners of hospitalization
6 of each county to such institutions as the commissioner of
7 the state department of social services may designate, or to
8 a private facility with approval of the board of supervisors
9 or when the patient or responsible relatives agree to pay the
10 full costs of hospitalization and have made the necessary
11 arrangements for admission and support.

12 Sec. 2. Section two hundred twenty-four point four (224.4),
13 Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:

14 224.4 PLACES OF COMMITMENT. The commissioner of the state
15 department of social services shall designate the state in-
16 stitutions to which commitments may be made under this chapter,
17 and to that end may divide the state into districts, and shall
18 promptly notify each clerk of the district court of such
19 designation and all changes therein.

20 EXPLANATION

21 Chapter 224 of the Code, relating to treatment of alcoholics
22 and drug addicts, presently provides only for commitment to a state
23 institution. In some instances, responsible relatives prefer
24 that a patient be committed to a private facility, with the
25 family assuming the entire cost of such private care. This
26 bill allows the commission of hospitalization to commit a
27 patient to a private facility upon the request of responsible
28 relatives when arrangements have been made for admission and
29 support, or when the county board of supervisors approves such
30 a commitment.

22 one (224.1) of the Code. The state department established
23 for the purpose of regulating drug abuse in the state of Iowa
24 shall designate the private facilities to which persons
25 suffering from the effects of drugs enumerated in section

- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section two hundred twenty-four point one
2 (224.1), Code 1973, as amended to read as follows:

3 224.1 COMMITMENT. Persons addicted to the excessive use
4 of intoxicating liquors, [*morphine, cocaine, or other*
5 *narcotic drugs*] or any controlled substance contained in
6 *schedules I, II, III, or IV of chapter two hundred four*
7 *(204) of the Code*
8 may be committed by the commissioners of hospitalization
9 of each county to such institutions as the commissioner of
10 the state department of social services may designate, or to
11 *such private facilities as the commission on alcoholism,*
12 *or a state department established for the purpose of regulat-*
13 *ing drug abuse in the state of Iowa, may designate; or to any*
14 *hospital accredited to give psychiatric care, provided that,*
15 *commitments to private facilities shall only be made upon*
16 *approval of the board of supervisors or upon agreement by the*
17 *patient or responsible relatives to pay the full costs of*
18 *treatment and upon having made the necessary arrangements for*
