A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate funds from the general fund of the state
 2 of Iowa to the state board of regents for capital improve-
 3 ments and purchases of land for institutions under the
 4 state board of regents including construction of new buildings,
 5 repairs, improvements, leases, land purchases, equipment,
 6 replacements, or alterations, and providing for joint control
 7 of the expenditures thereof by the board of regents, the
 8 governor, and the state comptroller.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1973,
3 and ending June 30, 1975, to the state board of regents the
4 sum of five million (5,000,000) dollars, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, to be used to supplement any prior appro-
6 priations for capital improvement items for construction of
7 new buildings and replacement of building space and equipment
8 lost through fires at the university of northern Iowa.

9 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of
10 the state for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1973,
11 and ending June 30, 1975, to the state board of regents the
12 sum of two million five hundred thousand (2,500,000) dollars,
13 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used to supple-
14 ment any prior appropriations for capital improvement items
15 for construction of a steam generator at Iowa state univer-
16 sity of science and technology.

17 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the general fund of
18 the state for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1973,
19 and ending June 30, 1975, to the state board of regents the
20 sum of one million six hundred thousand (1,600,000) dollars,
21 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used to supple-
22 ment any prior appropriations for capital improvement items
23 for construction of a meats laboratory at Iowa state univer-
24 sity of science and technology.

25 Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the general fund of
26 the state for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1973,
27 and ending June 30, 1975, to the state board of regents the
28 sum of two million two hundred ninety-five thousand (2,295,000)
29 dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used
30 to supplement any prior appropriations for capital improvement
31 items for construction of new buildings, repairs, improvements,
32 purchase of land, leases, equipment, replacements or altera-
33 tions, or for any other capital expenditures the board of
34 regents may deem necessary for the proper and necessary
35 function of any institution under its jurisdiction.

1 Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the general fund of
2 the state for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1973,
3 and ending June 30, 1975, to the state board of regents the
4 sum of seven thousand six hundred (7,600) dollars, or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary, to be used to supplement
6 any prior appropriations for capital improvement items for
7 replacement of building space and equipment lost through fires
8 at Iowa state university of science and technology.

9 Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the general fund of
10 the state for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1973,
11 and ending June 30, 1975, to the state board of regents the
12 sum of seventeen thousand four hundred (17,400) dollars, or
13 so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used to supple-
14 ment any prior appropriations for capital improvement items
15 for replacement of building space and equipment lost through
16 fires at the state university of Iowa.

17 Sec. 7. Contracts for improvements for which funds are
18 appropriated by this Act shall be submitted by the state board
19 of regents to the governor and the state comptroller, except
20 that items commonly known as change orders need not be sub-
21 mitted to the governor and the state comptroller unless such
22 change orders actually increase the total cost of that par-
23 ticular project.

24 Sec. 8. The state board of regents, the governor, and
25 the state comptroller may obtain federal grants for the state
26 to be used in connection with the funds appropriated by this
27 Act.

28 Sec. 9. Following awarding of contract of any project
29 provided in this Act, the unneeded balance of any appropri-
30 ation made by this Act for that project may be used to supple-
31 ment any current, prior, or subsequent appropriation for
32 capital improvements for the board of regents institutions.

33 Sec. 10. Any unencumbered balance of funds appropriated
34 by this Act remaining on June 30, 1977, shall revert to the
35 general fund on June 30, 1977.
