1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the "salary adjustment fund" within the gen-
3 eral fund of the state, herein created, for each year of the
4 biennium commencing July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975,
5 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be neces-
6 sary, to be used in the manner designated:

26 dollars on a full-time annual basis, such increase to be in
27 addition to the salary and wages previously scheduled to be-
28 come effective July 1, 1973. All exempt positions provided
29 for in section nineteen A point nine (19A.9), subsection two
30 (2), of the Code which are included in the state comptroller's
31 centralized payroll system shall be adjusted in a like amount
32 on a basis consistent with the appropriations as provided
33 by the general assembly.

34 Sec. 3. The salaries and wages of positions under the
35 jurisdiction of the state board of regents shall be increased

5 Sec. 4. Funds provided in section one (1) of this Act
6 shall relate to salaries supported from general fund appro-
7 priations and shall not be construed to replace revolving,
8 federal, trust or special funds where applicable.

9 Sec. 5. To departmental revolving, trust or special funds
10 for which the general assembly has established an operating
11 budget, a supplemental authorization is hereby provided from
12 those funds in an amount necessary to fund the salary adjust-
13 ment provided in section two (2) of this Act.

14 Sec. 6. The allocation of the funds appropriated in sec-
15 tions one (1) and five (5) of this Act shall be subject to
16 the approval of the governor and the state comptroller.
