A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to licenses for professional boxing and
2 wrestling matches.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
4 Section 1. Section seven hundred twenty-seven A point
5 four (727A.4), Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:
6 727A.4 LICENSE. No boxing or wrestling match shall be
7 held within this state except as provided in this chapter.
8 The commissioner may issue, suspend or revoke a license to
9 conduct boxing and wrestling matches ~~to any person~~ except
10 that a person shall not be issued a license unless he has
11 been a resident of this state for at least three years
12 immediately preceding the date of application, nor shall
13 any group, club, association or corporation be issued a
14 license unless it has been incorporated under the laws of
15 this state and has a membership of at least ten persons who
16 have been residents of this state for at least one year
17 immediately preceding the date of application. Nothing in
18 this chapter shall be construed to prohibit amateur boxing
19 or wrestling exhibitions. Every license shall be subject
20 to such rules and regulations as the commissioner may pre-
21 scribe.

EXPLANATION

22
23 This bill further qualifies those persons and organizations
24 who are eligible to be licensed to hold professional boxing
25 and wrestling matches. An individual must be a resident of

1 this state at the time of and for three years immediately
2 preceding this application for a license. A group, club,
3 association or corporation must be incorporated under the
4 laws of this state and have at least ten members who have
5 been residents of the state at least one year immediately
6 preceding the date of application to be eligible for a
7 professional boxing and wrestling license.

7 (727A), Code 1973, is amended by adding the following
8 new section:
9 NEW SECTION. There is established an athletic
10 commissioner's advisory commission to consist of seven
11 members appointed by the governor, and who shall
12 serve at the pleasure of the governor. The advisory
13 commission shall be nonpartisan and the members shall
14 be appointed without reference to political affiliation.
15 The athletic commissioner shall serve as chairman of
16 the advisory commission.
17 No member of the athletic commissioner's advisory
18 commission shall hold or be issued a license under the
19 provisions of this chapter.
