## A BILL FOR

1 An Act to provide for the nomination by political parties of  
2 candidates for special elections called pursuant to section  
3 sixty-nine point fourteen (69.14) of the Code.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section forty-three point seventy-eight (43.78),  
2 Code 1975, as amended by Acts of the Sixty-sixth General  
3 Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter eighty-one (81), section  
4 twenty-five (25), is amended by adding the following new  
5 subsection:

6 NEW SUBSECTION. Political party candidates for a vacant  
7 seat in the congress of the United States or the general  
8 assembly which is to be filled at a special election called  
9 pursuant to section sixty-nine point fourteen (69.14) of the  
10 Code shall be nominated in the manner provided by subsection  
11 one (1) of this section for filling a vacancy on the general  
12 election ballot for the same office. The name of any candidate  
13 so nominated shall be submitted in writing to the state  
14 commissioner, as required by section forty-three point eighty-  
15 eight (43.88) of the Code, at the earliest practicable time.

16 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
17 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-  
18 tion in The Sioux <sup>1/25/76</sup> City Journal, a newspaper published in Sioux  
19 City, Iowa, and in the Fort Dodge <sup>1/24/76</sup> Messenger, a newspaper  
20 published in Fort Dodge, Iowa.

21 EXPLANATION

22 Section 1 of this bill provides specific authority for  
23 political parties to nominate candidates for special elections  
24 to fill vacancies in Congress or the General Assembly. It  
25 should have been a part of House File 700, passed in 1975.  
26 That bill repealed Code section 43.84, the authority under  
27 which such nominations were formerly made.

HOUSE FILE 1033

AN ACT

TO PROVIDE FOR THE NOMINATION BY POLITICAL PARTIES OF CANDIDATES FOR SPECIAL ELECTIONS CALLED PURSUANT TO SECTION SIXTY-NINE POINT FOURTEEN (69.14) OF THE CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section forty-three point seventy-eight (43.78), Code 1975, as amended by Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter eighty-one (81), section twenty-five (25), is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. Political party candidates for a vacant seat in the congress of the United States or the general assembly which is to be filled at a special election called pursuant to section sixty-nine point fourteen (69.14) of the Code shall be nominated in the manner provided by subsection one (1) of this section for filling a vacancy on the general election ballot for the same office. The name of any candidate so nominated shall be submitted in writing to the state commissioner, as required by section forty-three point eighty-eight (43.88) of the Code, at the earliest practicable time.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Sioux City Journal, a newspaper published in Sioux
