AN ACT

APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE CAPITOL PLANNING COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 to the capitol planning commission the following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary:
